
Policies:

- To conduct a tree plantation campaign.
- To continuously enhance our energy consumption through additional measures.
- To ensure the availability of essential resources to accomplish our goals.
- To promote the use of advanced technology to minimize energy usage, air pollution, and noise, specifically in our vehicle fleets.
