

Student Feedback Analysis and Action Taken Report on Curriculum 2021-22

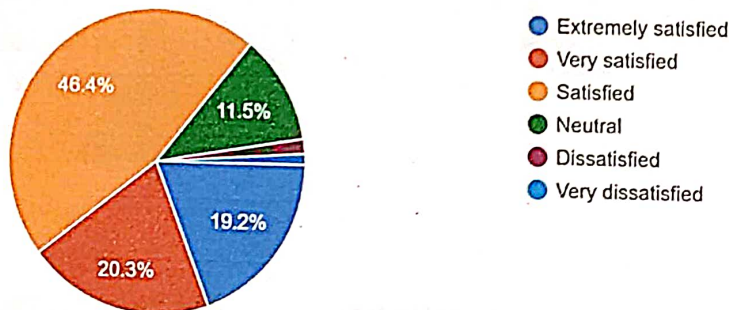
The institution gathered feedback from students regarding various aspects such as academic, curriculum, co-curricular, administration, and infrastructure, with the goal of improving the institution. The feedback was reviewed and discussed during an academic council meeting, and the valuable suggestions were taken into consideration to determine necessary actions.

Throughout the semester, students were asked to provide structured feedback on the teaching and learning process, syllabus content, and attainment of skill sets. This feedback was collected at two levels. Level-I feedback was gathered by the Head of Department directly from students in each class, two weeks after the start of the semester, about their respective course teachers. Level-II feedback was obtained through a structured feedback form using an online platform.

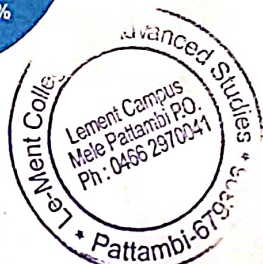
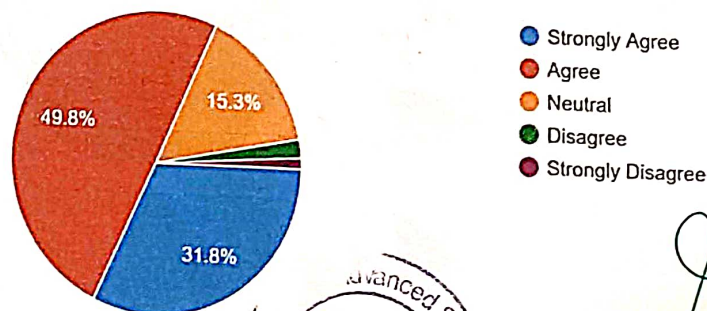
Are you satisfied with the teaching staff and their teaching methods?



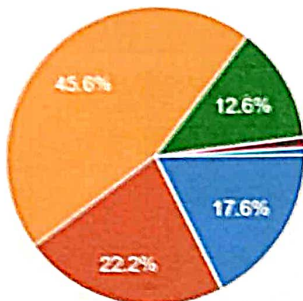



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How supportive were the faculty members?

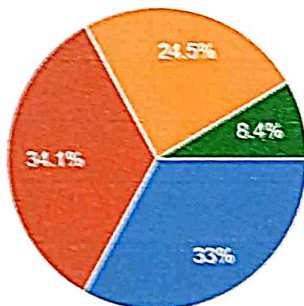

Does your teacher guide you in setting personal targets and developing strategies to achieve that target

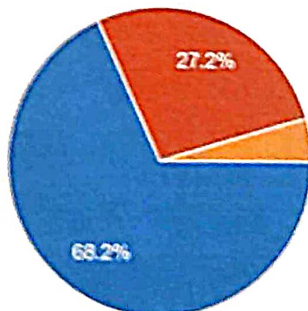

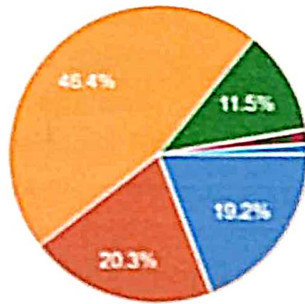

- Students have been given a chance to participate in club activities and other competitions through an online platform. Online PTM conducted .

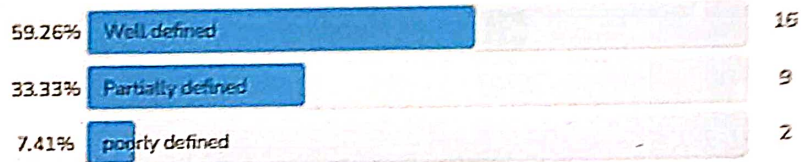



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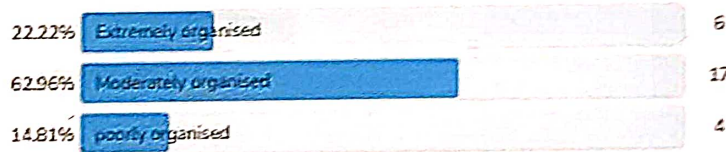
1. Whether the learning objectives are

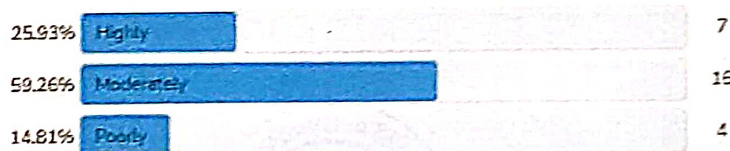
3. Were the course contents too challenging for an average students to understand?

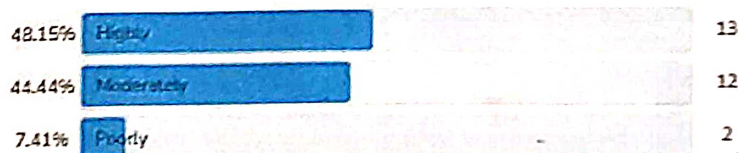
4. Whether the contents providing in-depth knowledge to the students



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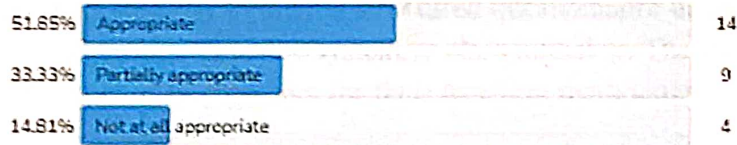
6. Relevance of course to daily life situation

STUDENTS FEEDBACK ANALYSIS

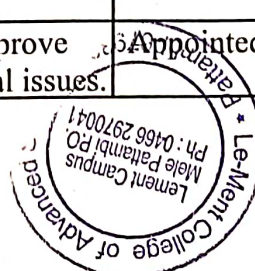


Even still they raised some issues directly with HOD and class tutor which are notified in the following table. The concern is discussed in academic council meetings and department meetings to take necessary actions.

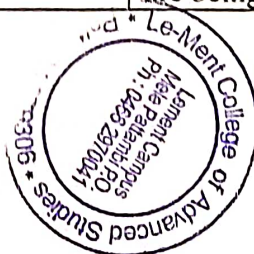
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

S.NO	FEED BACK	ACTION TAKEN
1.	Classes for slow learners:	All the faculty members were instructed to provide more remedial classes to the students who need it. It was also directed to provide them extra study material and notes.
2.	Accessibility to computer facility:	Students were dissatisfied that they were unable to access the computer facility in department. For this proposal was made to make more computers available for the students. The action under this point is still in progress as proper arrangements are being made.




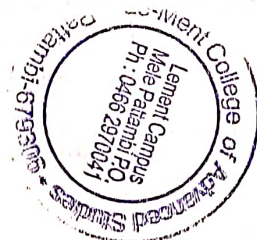

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Parents Feedback Analysis Report 2018-19

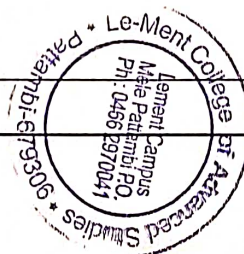

A few faculty members obtained fewer score and some students requested for change in teaching pedagogy adopted by the faculty. 2.	Students are satisfied with notes of teachers but suggested for notes to be provided by teachers who are not giving.	Teachers are advised to consider the concern there by students obtain awareness about topics covered in the syllabus in detail
3.	Sanitary napkins vendor should be available in the girls toilet	Efforts are being made to get a sanitary Napkin vendor installed.
4.	Some courses are feel to be difficult to understand	Teachers have been advised to spend more time on tough topics and deliver in simple way so that even a below average student could able to follow the class smoothly.




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5.	Request for more activities like club/events, extension etc. apart from academic activities.	Many clubs were introduced with teacher coordinator, training classes provided to encourage students to achieve various skills in their life, extension activities are done through social club.
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
Parents Feedback Analysis Report 2017-18

There is a greater interaction between teachers and parents. Parents who are unable to attend parent teacher meeting due to other engagements can voice their views to the class tutor. PTA Executive committee is selected.

Action Taken:

- Discipline and reputation of the institution are the most important factors in attracting the students. To improve discipline, created a discipline committee with HOD's and senior faculties as members.
- Adequate arrangement of water made in the toilets and drinking area.
- Additional efforts are made to teach tough topics especially basic concepts cleared properly.
- Changing of class tutorship in a year for each semester is changed to same class tutor for the whole academic year.




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
